OUR LEVELS

ESL Basic Level

For beginners, the focus is on the basics of grammar and practical vocabulary, as well as listening and speaking skills. Textbook is required.

ESL Intermediate Level

ESL Advanced Level

For students who completed the intermediate level. Emphasis will be on vocabulary, verbs, grammar, idiomatic expressions, pronunciation and conversation. Textbook is required.

For students who have a basic understanding of English. This class will encourage students to become comfortable using their speaking skills while building upon grammar and vocabulary. Conversations will involve everyday activities, current events and living in the USA topics.
